1. The Bidder should have experience of providing similar services and should bear a license for such purpose only. The bidder should have necessary license issued by the Competent Authority to run the contract carriage services.
2. The Bidder should read the General & Special Terms and Conditions of J&K Bank and give their acceptance to that effect.
3. Bid should be complete in all respects and incomplete bids will be summarily rejected. No clarification will be entertained by J&K Bank in this regard. The Bidders should duly sign the entire tender documents.
4. Failure to fulfill any of the conditions given above shall render the tender for rejection.
5. J&K Bank does not bind to accept the lowest or any tender and reserves the right of accepting the whole or any part of the RFP and the Bidders shall be bound to accept and perform the same at the rates quoted.
6. The bidder should be competent enough to deal with the contract of the tendered item / services technically and financially and should have adequate man-power (skilled/semi-skilled/unskilled and technical) required for managing the work awarded.
7. The bidder should produce Income Tax Certificate for the last 3 Assessment Years in addition to PAN. The bidders should provide GST No. and other necessary documents as may be required.
8. The offers should be submitted within the stipulated time and delay if any occurred in submission on account of any reason, whatsoever, shall not be condoned and such delayed offers received late shall be liable for rejection.
9. The bidder or his authorized representative will be entitled to participate in the tender opening process to take note of the proceedings of disclosure.

10. J&K Bank reserves the right of cancellation, adding, reducing or deferring the tender in total or partially without assigning any reason thereof and claim in this behalf in any way shall not be tenable for compensation in any respect. In such case the bidder will be refunded with the earnest money deposit without any payment of interest.

11. Bank may ask for any documents at the time of evaluation of the Technical Bid.

**TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR
HIRING OF BIG/MINIBUSES**

(Please read the following instructions carefully and give acceptance for the same at the end)

A) SCOPE OF WORK:

The Bidder will have to provide the facility through its **own cash van registered on its name** as given below:

- **Pickup and drop of cash** from destinations (as per schedule) to the office premises.
- The **Cash Van service** will be provided **Six days in a week** (Monday to Saturday).
- The service may be **extended on weekly holidays and Govt. holidays**, if required by J&K Bank.
- The cash van to be provided must be of **2022 or later model**.

A. Minimum Eligibility Criteria for Tender Submission

(i) The Bidders should have experience in providing similar contract carriage services. The Bidder should have a valid Contract Carriage License to run such services (attested copy of the license should be attached along with the Eligibility bid).

(ii) The Bidders should be able to adhere to the following instructions and guidelines issued by Govt. of Maharashtra, Commerce and Transport Department.

- (a) The Cash Van should bear a **number plate**.
- (b) The Cash Van must have a **first aid box and fire extinguisher**.
- (c) The doors and windows of the cash van must be secured with a **reliable locking system**.
- (d) The bus must be provided with a **driver and collie** (porter).

B) VEHICLE REQUIREMENT

- The cash van shall be as per latest RBI specifications & requirements.
- The cash van should be light commercial vehicle with an engine capacity of not less than 2200CC and have a ground clearance of not less than 190mm and can accommodate minimum of 5 passengers.
- The CCTV fitted in the cash compartment with a monitor on the panel for the driver to view it and have minimum five days recording facility
- A security Alarm with GSM based auto dialer shall be provided with a motorized siren.
- Another camera fitted in the backside to view on the screen by the gunman sitting in the cash enclosure to monitor any person if chasing the cash van.
- Radio Tracking Facility in the Cash van for Driver/Gunmen to remain in constant touch with control room.
- Cash van to have a strong steel body with all windows and glasses grilled.
- Enclosure for the safe and for the Gunman to sit will be separated from the driver's compartment with a grill.
- There would be a locking facility from inside the cash van which cannot be opened from outside.
- The cash will be kept in a safe which will have a separate locking system.

- All windows and screens have wire mesh protection of not more than one square inch and each window mesh shall have a circular port-hole of six inches diameter for the use of weapons.
- The cash van must be equipped with fire extinguishers and emergency light.
- The panic switches for operating the hooter are available with the driver and other occupants.
- The Vehicle should be in **road-worthy conditions**, in all respects, for operation in accordance with **Maharashtra RTO rules and regulations**. All necessary documents, including the **Registration Certificate, Insurance Certificate, Route Permit, and Fitness Certificate**, should be available in the vehicle with the driver during operation. **Responsibility for any lapses in this regard shall be that of the contractor.**
- The van should be **neat and clean** from inside and outside, and in **perfect mechanical condition**. The van will be **inspected periodically for roadworthiness**. Any defect pointed out by J&K Bank should be **rectified immediately**. The contractor shall provide **another vehicle of 2023 or later model** in good condition, as a replacement, during the period of repair/servicing.

C) GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- (i) The contract entered into will be in force on or after _____, (tentative) for a period of Two years.
- (ii) The average daily distance covered by the cash van will be around 100 km and same will be calculated on monthly basis.
- (iii) The contractor should produce all documents issued by RTO concerned relating to cash van for verification. If cash van is not registered in the name of contractor, it will not be accepted.
- (iv) The contract can be terminated by J&K Bank by giving one months' notice without assigning any reason thereof.
- (v) The cash van should have comprehensive insurance to cover the risk of injury and loss of life of the drivers, attendant and third parties by law including damages to property belonging to them.
- (vi) The contractor has to provide the Driver and porter for the cash van.
- (vii) Award of contract to successful Bidders will not entail him/them exclusive right to supply the cash van for which the tender has been submitted by the Bidders.
- (viii) All repairs including major overhaul and maintenance, servicing and other expenses for the up-keep of the cash van, running expenses such as tyres, batteries etc. shall be borne by the contractor. The wages payable to the Driver and helper of the van shall be the responsibility of the contractor and the same should be in compliance to minimum wages act.
- (ix) The cash van should have tubeless tyres, wireless (mobile) communication and hooters. The vans should not follow the same route and timing repeatedly so as to become predictable. Predictable movement on regular routes must be discouraged. Staff should be rotated and assigned only on the day of the trip. With regard to security, additional regulations / guidelines as prescribed by Private Security Agencies (Regulation) Act, 2005, the Government of India and the State Governments from time to time must be adhered to.
- (x) The Character and antecedent verification of all members (Driver and porter) provided by the

successful bidder and associated with cash van movement, should be done meticulously. Strict background check of the Driver and porter should include police verification of at least the last two addresses. Such verification should be updated periodically and shared on a common database at industry level. The SRO can play a proactive role in creating a common data base for the industry. In case of dismissal of an employee, the CIT / CRA concerned should immediately inform the police with details.

(xi) The cash van shall follow the routes and rallying points as per the details to be provided by Bank and no deviation will be allowed unless it is due to some unforeseen reasons such as traffic jam or diversion of the route by the Traffic Police or Municipal Authorities. However, Bank reserves the right to change the schedule/ route at any time.

(xii) The contractor shall ensure that **drivers deployed** on the cash van are **qualified** and possess a **valid professional License** (with a minimum of **5 years' experience**) issued by the appropriate authority, and are also **well-disciplined**. They should:

- Behave properly with the staff and officials.
- Be **well conversant with the route/roads** of Mumbai / Navi Mumbai and its surroundings.
- The contractor shall not sublet, transfer or assign the contract to any other party.

(xiii) The contractor shall produce the original documents of the cash van and drivers under contract for verification as and when called for by Bank authorities.

(xiv) If the contract is terminated on the basis of non-compliance of terms and conditions of the contract, security deposit shall stand forfeited.

(xv) The contractor shall furnish agreement on non-judicial stamp paper of ₹ 100 /- accepting all the terms and conditions mentioned in the tender document at the time of award of the contract for supply of buses. Any conditional acceptance of the offer will be liable for immediate termination of the contract without assigning any reason whatsoever. The terms and conditions of this RFP will form a part of an Agreement.

(xvi) J&K Bank reserves the right to disqualify the Bidders blacklisted by State/Central Govt. undertakings/Public Sector Units / Pvt Co. or whose contracts have been terminated by J&K Bank on account of poor performance. This right applies if such information comes to the knowledge of the Bank at any stage, either during the tendering process or after short listing the bidder.

(xvii) The bidder shall declare that no conflict of interest exists, and that neither the bidder nor its affiliates have been blacklisted or debarred by any Government/PSU institution.

(xviii) The bidder shall hold a valid Private Security Agencies Regulation Act (PSARA) license for carrying out cash-in-transit operations.

(xix) CCTV recording shall be maintained and preserved for a minimum period of 90 days from the date of recording.

(xx) The maximum cash limit per van per trip shall not exceed ₹5 crore or the insurer's limit, whichever is lower.

(xxi) All crew members shall undergo police verification, medical fitness certification, and periodic background checks before deployment.

(xxii) The eligibility criteria shall include experience of at least 5 years in cash transportation and compliance with all RBI-prescribed operational and safety standards for Cash-in-Transit operations.

(xxiii) The bidder shall be required to sign an Integrity Pact in line with CVC Office Order No. 41/12/07 for all contracts exceeding ₹10 lakh.

D) COMPLIANCE OF LAWS AND SAFETY RULES

- (i) The contractor shall declare and warrant that they are legally entitled to do the services of providing transport and hold the requisite license and/or permit for the same from the appropriate authorities.
- (ii) The contractor shall employ his own drivers, cleaners, porter/coolie during the period of contract and shall pay their wages and comply with the statutory provisions and Bank shall not, in any manner, be responsible for the same. The contractor shall make payment of wages to the workers employed by him regularly.
- (iii) It will be the sole responsibility of the Contractor to abide by the statutory provisions of the various acts in performance of this contract:
- (iv) All payment as may be required for obtaining different permits and license in contractor's line of buses will be obtained by the contractors at their cost.
- (v) In order to avoid mishap / accident, contractor shall ensure that only skilled drivers (having driving license to drive commercial vehicles) with an experience of 5 years in the trade are deployed on cash van and they observe all rules / precautions in this regard.
- (vi) If the cash van is involved in any accident or mishap and as a result thereof any employee/s of Bank suffer any injury or death then the contractor shall be liable to pay compensation or damages as may be assessed by the appropriate authority.
- (vii) The Contractor shall be responsible for any damages to the cash van or any death or injury to the driver or any of the bank employees travelling in the buses in case of any accident. Bank will not entertain to any litigation whatsoever under any circumstances

E) RESOLUTION OF DISPUTES

Notwithstanding anything contained, all questions, disputes or differences whatsoever, between the parties to the Contract, arising out of or relating to the operation or interpretation or provision of the contract or matters related thereto, whether during the tenure of the Contract, or its failure or after the completion of the Contract, shall be settled by the bank authority. The decision of the bank shall be final and binding on the parties to the Contract.

F) JURISDICTION:

The parties hereto agree that any matter or issue arising hereunder or any dispute hereunder shall be subject to exclusive jurisdiction of courts situated at Mumbai.

G) COMPLIANCE WITH RTI RULES

- (i) The contractor shall ensure that all the rules pertaining to Motor vehicle Act and any other Act of the state shall be met. In no circumstances bank shall be involved for any violation of the RTI Rules on the part of the transporter. It will be the sole responsibility of the contractor to abide by all such laws.
- (ii) The contractor shall ensure that the drivers do not carry any inflammable / contraband material in the cash van.

H) ADVERTISEMENT AND BRANDING OF BUSES

- (i) Bank reserves the right to display advertisements of its choice, on the cash van and the Contractor shall not have any objection nor shall claim any advertisement revenue thereof.

I) SAFETY AND SECURITY

- (i) In order to avoid any Mishap / Accident, contractor shall ensure that only skilled drivers (having driving license to drive passenger buses) with experience of 5 years in the trade are

deployed on cash van and he observe all rules / precautions in this regard. Contractor shall ensure that driver donot exceed normal speed limit and shall further ensure that his crew is deployed on duty after adequate rest to avoid accidents due to over fatigue.

(ii) The contractor shall engage the drivers for bank duty whose character and antecedent verification has been done by the Police Department, possess valid commercial driving license, having thorough knowledge of traffic rules / road safety precautions, aware with the routes of Mumbai / Navi Mumbai and its surroundings.

(iii) The drivers of the cash van should follow the traffic rules prominently.

(iv) The Contractor or his representative shall not divulge to anyone, any confidential information obtained during the course of work.

J) GPS DEVICE WITH RFID(RADIO-FREQUENCYIDENTIFICATION)-VEHICLETRACKING

(i) The contractor should install GPS tracking device and should make with the provision of RFID /Digital Mode.

ii. The installation and maintenance charge should be borne by the Bidder/Contractor only.

iii. AlldeployedvehiclesfromBidder/Contractorshouldhavespeedgovernors.

K) PENALTIES

(i) In case of breakdown, a substitute cash van of the same or later model in good condition shall be deployed immediately. If the contractor does not provide a substitute van within the stipulated time, he shall be liable to pay the charges and expenses that may be incurred by Bank for reaching the destination by arranging other mode of transport.

(ii) If the contractor is not able to provide the fixed cash van on any day(s) due to maintenance / repairing work or for any other reason, failing which a penalty of ₹ 5000/- per instance will be imposed and recovered from the bill of the contractor.

L) SECURITYDEPOSIT

A) Earnest Money

(i) All bidders have to provide Earnest money deposit in the shape of FDR/bank Guarantee of Rs 40000/= which will be returned to other vendors within 30 days after the contract is signed. In case, the successful bidder fails to supply the service, the earnest money shall be forfeited.

B) Performance Guarantee

(ii) The selected bidder shall be required to provide a performance guarantee as Bank Guarantee, FDR or any other form of deposit, @7% of the contract value.

M) BILLINGANDPAYMENT

(i) The bill shall be submitted for each calendar month duly completed in all respects by 5th of succeeding month. Receipt of toll charges, if any to be duly submitted along with the bills t he payment to the contractor shall be made by Bank through NEFT/RTGS subject to deduction of TDS,if applicable.

(ii) If the bills are sent back for any correction to the contractor, the date of re-submission

of the bill after correction will be considered the date of actual submission of the bill.

(iii) The rates offered in the schedule of rates (Annexure-II) should include all the expenses such salary payable of drivers/attendants, porter, road tax, passenger permit charges, insurance of buses, parking charges, maintenance charges, etc. Only monthly charges plus toll charges will be paid by Bank for monthly hiring of big/minibuses.

N) FORCEMAJEURE

Force Majeure is herein defined as any cause which is beyond the control of the contractor and the bank, as the case may be, which they could not foresee or with a reasonable amount of diligence could not have foreseen and which substantially affects the performance of the contract, such as Natural Phenomena, including but not limited to floods, droughts, earthquakes and epidemics. Other phenomena including but not limited to hostilities, riots, civil commotion and declared lockout, etc.
